- ●I-D-E-S re-arranged is D-I-E-S or "dies", as in death. "THE IDES OF MARCH" is exactly "THE MARCH OF DIES" with a slight re-arrangement. "M" is the 13th(unlucky #13) letter of the alphabet. Add an "M" to "dies" and you get "dimes". "THE IDES OF MARCH" is the name "THE MARCH OF DIMES".
