people would keep such a secret from the people they use such a system on? Why would they keep it secret and not show their true methods on TV or even in medical documentaries?

● Over one hundred and fifty(150) years ago, the ANCIENT ORDER were using this system to control others without their knowing they were being controlled. They boldly wrote books about what they were doing just as they place this system hidden in movies today. One such book they wrote was Mary Shelley's FRANKENSTEIN.
