to the doctor and the Laser Rays:

"...the scientific super-criminal invents a hypno-ray..."

It then goes on to say that the "criminal mastermind/asylum inmate/scientific super-criminal" tries to take over an entire country, England, using his invention, the "hypno-ray" or hypnotizing ray.

 Also in the 22 33 "33rd" year of 1933, the ANCIENT ORDER made H.G. Wells "THE INVISIBLE MAN" into a movie. THE INVISIBLE MAN is about a: "...mad scientist who makes himself invisible, wreaking havoc ... "
