THE ANCIENT ORDER'S CODES AND THE BOMBING OF PEARL HARBOR

• PEARL HARBOR was bombed on December 7, 1941. That date was chosen according to the ANCIENT ORDER's codes. The ANCIENT

Pearly Har/bor n large U.S. naval base near Hosolulu, scene of the Japanese surprise attack Dec. 7, 1941 that precipitated U.S. entry into World War II

ORDER use 2 name-totals: 126 and 159.

ANCIENT(66) + ORDER(60) = 126 THE(33) + ANCIENT(66) + ORDER(60) = 159

has the 365 days of the year 1-month-59-days apart. The "126" List appears below. In the case of the "126", it takes 32 lines before the dates line up in order. In the case of the "159" List above, it takes 41 lines. Look at the 41's below.

 \bullet 31 - 7 = 24. There were 24 days left in the year when Pearl Harbor was bombed. 365 - 24 = 341. Dec. 7 is the 341st day of the year.

The year 1941 ends on the 15,341st day of the 1900's.

ANCIENT(66) + ORDER(60) + 126

ANCIENT ORDER adds to 126. Relow is the ANCIENT ORDER's "126" code List, the days of the year 1-month-26-days apart. For the "126" code List they use 31 days for the month, 31 * 26 = 57. Each of these dates is exactly 57 days from the other. All 365 days are here, the first being the 57th day, February 26.

- Above is the "126" List, each of the 365 days of the year with the date that is 1-month-26-days from it. The List starts with the first, Feb. 26, and ends with the last, Dec. 31st.
- The term "BEAST OF BURDEN" is used to refer to persons meant for suffering. The ANCIENT ORDER code it: BOB, 202, 22 or 2/2, February 2nd.
- •Pearl Harbor was bombed on Dec. 7, #38 on the "126" List. The next, #39 is February 2nd. Pearl Harbor was bombed exactly 1-month-26-days from the ANCIENT ORDER's Beast of Burden day and on the 341st day of the 41st year which ended on the 15,341st day of the 1900's.
